Check your steps:

KEEP FARMS CLEAN



Do not pick when sick

•Use good judgement if sick.

WHY? Your germs could make someone else sick!



Keep pets at home

- Pets may leave behind germs and pests.
- Pets may harm plants by digging.

WHY? Pets can also spread germs that make people sick.



Keep food & drinks out

- •Litter can attract unwanted pests.
- Others may be allergic.
- •No gum or smoking.

WHY? Germs can make other people sick.



Wash hands before & after picking

- Ask the staff where the restrooms are.
- •Hand sanitizer only works if hands are NOT dirty.
- •Wash with soap, water, and paper towels.
- •Clean and cover cuts.

WHY? Unwashed hands can spoil produce.



Kid farm safety

- •Keep kids with an adult.
- •Plants are not toys.

WHY? Plants can easily be damaged.
