- Federal Military Licensing Program
 - The Board reviewed the new federal regulation. Still requires for the verification of good standing from other jurisdictions.

- HB325/SB290 Update -
 - The Board was informed that HB325/SB290 was passed.
 - Nathan to draft regulation changes regarding the training and administration of Rabies vaccines by shelter staff.
- Nathan attended the HSUS and AAVSB conferences during April and provided a summary of information presented at the conferences.
 - Discussions about Telehealth
 - Discussions about Reciprocity agreements.
- PET IQ Status and renewal
 - The Board discussed the status of the existing program.
 - Inspectors explained issues occurring with PET-IQ Mobile facilities.
 - In a motion by Dr. Callahan, and seconded by Dr. Reed, the Board voted unanimously to extend the program allowing for 1 responsible veterinarian for multiple limited use hospitals for 6 more months, to be reevaluated in October 2023.
- Inquiry from Dr. Shawn Wilson Is passing a urinary catheter, deobstipation of a cat, or unblocking a UO cat are considered surgery? Reading through the bylaws it states that a technician may not perform surgery. I hold the position that the above items are not surgery. Are licensed veterinary technicians able to perform the above tasks with supervision?
 - Dr. Handel responded to a similar inquiry from a Technician. "I do not think that it is appropriate for a veterinary technician to do either of these procedures. I do not consider either unblocking a male cat or deobstipation a surgical procedure . These are both medical procedures that do require some form of anesthesia. Both procedures can be very technically challenging with many potential complications. These complications can be life threatening."
 - If the procedure requires sedation or anesthesia a veterinarian should be performing the procedure. The Board would not approve of a Technician performing these procedures.
- Dr. James Katsimis Special Request Would like to apply for Maryland License meets the requirements under the Out of State license by being a licensed veterinarian in CT for the last 30 years. Would like approval to submit an application without the ECFVG certificate.
 - The Board reviewed Dr. Katsimis' request and approved him to apply for licensing. Application will still be reviewed.
