- PDMP Advisory Board Presentation
 - Anna Gribble and Sara Roberson from MDH-PDMP provided a presentation on upcoming legislation proposals to strengthen controlled substance reporting guidelines for veterinarians.
 - The Board Provided the following feedback:
 - Concerns over the definition of "Dispenser" when it comes to veterinarians.
 - Want to help and contribute to the solution of the substance problem.
 - Concerns over operation and software costs to make this feasible.
 - Concerns over pushing veterinarians away from dispensing medications that may cause an impact in the care of animals due to burden placed on veterinarians.
 - PDMP will take the feedback to their legal team to determine the best course of action.
- Chapter 1- 15.14.01 Standards of Practice Discussion
 - Will attempt to include the drug inventory logs in these changes of regulations.
- Executed Public Actions on Open Meeting Minutes
 - Executed Public Actions will be included in the Open Meeting Minutes for anything finalized since the previous meeting.
- Military Veterinarians
 - A Military Veterinarian doesn't need to be licensed in Maryland as long as maintaining a Military Veterinary License and practicing in the service.

 - The Board discussed information that they would like communicated to veterinarians:
 - License Renewals
 - Online CE allowance in FY24 renewal
 - Rabies Vaccines
 - By Veterinarian Only
 - Fill out the Certificates

 - Selling Practice Transfer of Hospital License
 - Expired medications -Opened and being used (don't forget to check ointments, ophthalmics, lidocaine)
